Basics of the USMLE Step 2 CK Exam

- 9 hour test
 - 8 hours → 8 blocks of 60 min for test taking.
 - Each block consists of 44 questions for a total of 352 questions.
 - Multiple choice questions
 - 1 hour → 45 min for breaks + 15 min for tutorial
 - If you finish any 60 min block early, that time is added to your break time
 - You can take the break time however you want it. Examples:
 - 4 test blocks → 60 min break → 3 test blocks
 - 1 test block (55 min) → 15 min break → 1 test block (55 min) → 15 min break...
- Scores: determine your goal
 - 184
 - 200
 - 229
 - 230
 - 239
- Step 2 focuses on principles of clinical science and making a diagnosis



Tools for Study

- A. Recommended Books and Study Guides – Use the books that you already know and trust!
 - Step-Up for Step 2
 - *Step-Up for Step 2* is the most comprehensive and contains the least amount of gaps
 - An average US medical student using only Step-Up for Step 2 + DIT + Question Bank can attain a score of 239, which is the current Doctors In Training average score.
- B. Books and Study Guides that **are not recommended**.
 - *Crush*: Textbook type of publication (Topic and paragraph book similar to First Aid.)
 - *Boards and Wards*: Too much ward information. It was never intended to be utilized as a Step 2 prep book
 - *First Aid for Step 2 CK*: Too much low-yield information, poor formatting makes it difficult to learn, missing high-yield information

 - Has the highest yield questions for Step 2
 - Receives the most positive student feedback
